

# NATIONAL CLYDESDALE BREEDERS FUTURITY CUP ENTRY FORM

## **OBJECTIVE:**

The objective and purpose of the National Clydesdale Breeders Futurity Cup is to promote Clydesdale horses and breeders of Clydesdale horses. The sale of Clydesdale horses through this sale will act as a venue to educate people, enhance genetics and bloodlines of the breed, educate on showing of the breed, and to generally ensure the continuation of the Clydesdale breed.

## **CONCEPT:**

Registered yearlings will be entered into the National Clydesdale Breeders Futurity Cup at the National Clydesdale Sale. These horses have the opportunity to show in classes at the National Clydesdale Sale. These classes include 2 year-old- Halter classes one year and then 3 year old halter classes and Cart Class the following year. Premiums and payouts for these classes will be paid from the Futurity as listed in the payout sections of this document.

## **RULES:**

1. All horses nominated must be Registered through the appropriate country breed registry. A copy of the front and back of the Registration Certificate must be furnished with entry and for future identification.
2. Horses must be entered in the National Clydesdale Sale, using the guidelines and official form of the National Clydesdale Sale. All Entry fee rules and commissions of the National Clydesdale Sale will apply.
3. The Futurity Nomination fee will be \$600 (one time fee) to be paid from proceeds upon sale of horse. The 8% commission from the sale of the horse will be split 50/50 between the National Clydesdale Sale and the National Clydesdale Breeders Futurity Cup.
4. All Futurity entries present at the National Clydesdale Sale must go through the sale ring. "No Sales" are permitted. The consignor must pay the 8% no sale fee plus the \$600 entry fee to the Futurity.
5. Horses from the Futurity sale will be eligible to show in Futurity classes at the National Clydesdale Sale.
6. The Futurity Cup Committee, along with past participants of the Futurity Cup have agreed to have one judge for the Futurity Classes in 2010. As the Futurity Cup program grows, the 3 panel judging system will be revisited for future years. In the event a horse is re-sold during the Futurity process, the nomination shall transfer with the horse to the new owner.
7. Horses may be shown as 2 year olds at Halter. The top 4 of each class shall be pulled for over all line up.
8. Horses may be shown as 3 year olds with points given in Halter Classes, then Cart Classes with High Point Panel System in effect. In the event of a tie, the highest points received in the cart class will determine the tie-breaker.
9. Sponsorship shall be encouraged.
11. Stalls for futurity class participants shall be complimentary at the National Clydesdale Sale. In the event the futurity entry will also be going thru the sale, the normal fee schedule will be applied.
